

WORKPLACE HAZARD RECOGNITION

Controlling workplace hazards involves making use of knowledge and skills in order to properly identify situations that could lead to hazards or accidents if not promptly dealt with. We will discuss the Hazard Recognition Process with participants. This is a very effective tool to assist in recognizing what a hazard is. As part of this program we will answer the following questions:

- What is a risk?
- What is an accident?
- What is an incident?
- What workplace factors (conditions) could contribute to an accident?
- What is the "root cause" of a hazard?
- What are the different ways to identify workplace hazards?

- Understand the concepts of: hazard, risk, safety hazards, health hazards and contributing factors

- Appreciate the principles of the Job Task Analysis and Standard Operating Procedure
- Apply theories as they relate to workplace inspections/accident investigations
