

WORKING AT HEIGHTS REFRESHER

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Who can take refresher training?

Only learners who have previously successfully completed a CPO-approved working at heights training program delivered by a CPO-approved working at heights training provider are eligible to take refresher training.

When do learners need refresher training?

Learners who wish to ensure that their CPO-approved working at heights training remains valid must successfully complete refresher training within three (3) years of the date that they successfully completed an approved program.

Nonetheless, learners who do not complete refresher training within three (3) years may take it at any time after this three (3) year period to renew its validity.

Do learners need to take refresher training with the same approved training provider that they completed their working at heights training?

Learners may register to take their refresher training with any CPO-approved training provider

What if learners lose their CPO-issued proof of training?

Learners who have lost their CPO-issued proof of training card can request a replacement card by calling the Ministry of Labour Health & Safety Contact Centre at 1-877-202-0008.

Will learners receive a new CPO proof of completion after refresher training?

After a learner successfully completes their refresher training, an approved training provider must issue a proof of completion to successful learners and notify the CPO. Upon receipt of these learner records, the CPO will issue a new proof of training card to the learner
