The BCA is pleased to award a bursary to student(s) enrolled in a post-secondary institution or construction trade apprenticeship for up to \$1000.00 each.

This bursary will be presented to student(s) who have graduated or are graduating with a minimum of Grade 12 or equivalent and have demonstrated a combination of academic and trade merit and have a financial need.

The student must be enrolled in a construction apprenticeship program, construction technology, construction engineering (degree) or any other construction related post-secondary program.

The applicant(s) must be residents of Ontario and Canadian Citizens or provide proof of landed immigrant status.

To apply for the scholarship please submit the following in the order provided:

- ✓ Completed application form
- ✓ Completed introductory letter (outlining career goals, involvement in community service or volunteer work and financial challenges)
- ✓ High school transcript (copy acceptable)
- ✓ Up to date resume
- ✓ Copy of Apprenticeship application (if applicable)
- ✓ Letter of acceptance into a relevant institution or post-secondary program (if applicable)
- ✓ Brief submission (written or digital) of your experience in the construction industry
- ✓ Minimum of two references from an employer or teacher from the last 2 years.

Submission Requirements

Applications must be completed and submitted prior to the deadline. Applicants are responsible to ensure their application is clear and legible; if the Selection Committee can't read the application, it will be disqualified.

The Selection Committee will, upon review of the applications, determine the recipient(s) of the award and notify the recipient(s) of his/her selection shortly thereafter.

Note: Only the successful candidates will be notified of results.
