- ✓ Brief submission (written or digital) of your experience in the construction industry.
- \checkmark Minimum of two references from an employer or teacher from the last 2 years. Submission Requirements

Applications must be completed and submitted prior to January 31, 2026. Applicants are responsible to ensure their application is clear and legible; if the Selection Committee is unable to read the application, it will be disqualified.

The Selection Committee will, upon review of the applications, determine the recipient of the award and notify the recipient of his/her selection shortly thereafter.
